Committee updates:

- **Finance (Gail C.)**
 - o AAA as of 11-20-06 is \$6725.00 short
 - o AAA has 132 donors with 14 new families and 45 in the 1% club
 - o PPC supports recommendation for a 2nd collection in January on a Sunday without one. May help to make up difference
 - o Religious Ed. made \$2300.00 off the Boutique and a donor gave a matching amount of \$2300.00 totaling \$5600.00
 - o Slightly ahead this year over previous on the budget/weekly donations.
 - o Next years AAA is less \$300.00 from this years, \$65700.00
- **Building and Grounds (Dcn. Paul L.)**
 - o Toilets are once again becoming plugged with excess paper from ESL. Al Huber fixed them by plunging.
 - o Additional lights have been added outside the east side of the church to illuminate the circle drive. Al Huber and Paul completed the work.
 - o Gail C. would like to have the missing fluorescent light cover in the handicap bathroom replaced also the faucet in the bathroom is leaking slow to moderately. Dcn. Paul will inquire with Al. Huber on faucet.
 - o School district custodian will be providing 150 new chairs for the ESL school. St. Luke just has to dispose of the old ones.
 - o School custodian also dropped of two to three months supply of paper products.
 - o FCFD on 10/30/06 noted that the emergency flood lights in the nave area not functioning. The back up batteries that power the lights are no longer good and can not be replaced. Church needs to replace both units.
 - o MetroFi is installed and operational; however, need to upgrade from the free service to the \$20.00/mo. For tech help and email benefits.
 - o Anthony and John S. are investigating the replacement of burned out bulbs in the parking lot lights.
